**F2** This week F2 have had great fun exploring pumpkins, creating their own leaf men and finding out about the festival of Diwali

Year 1 The children really enjoyed developing their computing skills by creating some vibrant digital paintings. The children really enjoyed experimenting with all of the different tools the Paintz web application makes available to them. Year 1 created Halloween and Bonfire Night themed pictures, some of which combined digital painting and typing skills!

Year 2 We have listened to stories set on islands, linked to our book The Storm Whale. The children have loved coming up with their own island characters to create their own island story

**Year 3** We have created their own spooky poems using expanded noun phrases. They have also learnt some interesting facts about spiders and some children were brave enough to hold a tarantula skin. **Year 6** We have enjoyed sharing our knowledge of the adaptations that animals have made in order to both survive and evolve. We have also taken part in a live lesson with the author Jeffrey Boayke and looked at how we relate to pieces of music, how they affect us and also how they portray the events of the day.
